Interreg-European Territorial Co-operation (ETC) - **why?**

- To decrease the negative impacts of borders for the regional development
- To enhance co-operation and integration among partners who share a "common space"

From Interreg II to ETC- steady increase in financing (ERDF*)

- 1994-1999: INTERREG II -
3.5 billion
- 2000-2006: INTERREG III -
5.8 billion
- 2007-2013: **European Territorial Cooperation**
8.7 billion of ERDF

Steady increase in funding available (although also increase in area covered post 2004...)

Total	5.8 bn €	8.7 bn €

A wide menu for cross-border cooperation - what can be supported?

- Entrepreneurship and SMEs, cross-border trade, tourism and culture
- Protection and joint management of the environment
- Better access to transport
- Information and communication networks
- Water, waste management and energy management systems
- Joint use of health, culture and education infrastructure
- Judicial and administrative co-operation



Interreg x European Territorial Co-operation: **Is it the same?**

Yes...

- Cross border, transnational and interregional strands untouched
- Support on NUTS III level
- Elementary objectives still valid (reducing barriers, enhancing co-operation)



Interreg x European Territorial Co-operation: **Is it the same?**

...and **No!**

- Lead partner principle
- **Formalized** co-operation criteria
- More funding, bigger co-financing rate
- **More ambitious goals**: Lisbon and Gothenburg agendas, strategic, long-term impact on cross border area



Which projects to support?

- **Strategic** - long term impact, bigger scale, based on analysis of needs and opportunities
- **Innovative**

How?

Thematic calls, commissioned projects

- Genuinely joint (no co-operation „on paper“)
- Profit/impact for both AT and CZ part of CBC area



Important principles

- Environmental impact
- Equal opportunities (men-women)
- No discrimination (handicapped, ethnic groups)
- Publicity and communication
- Synergies with other relevant programmes (EU-funded or national)
- Close monitoring and evaluation of results (Monitoring Committee to play a strong role)



Achievements of CBC in Europe thanks to Interreg

CBC clusters, science parks, research institutes, hospitals, water treatment plants, highways...

Result in - in cross border areas + in the EU in general:

More trust , civil engagement of local and regional actors, better environment - better life quality, greater economic growth, reaching the critical mass (for clusters, research)...

- "cross-border conference" for the development of a joint strategy of enhancement of the mountain landscape
Combination of environmental protection measures and the promotion of socio-economic activities



AT-CZ co-operation achievements

- Long-term co-operation bases founded (e.g. 2002 *Euregio Silva Nortica - today: Strategy of the Euroregions 2007-2013, „Gute Nachbarn“, CENTROPE projects)
- Interesting projects supported (co-operational development of localities in Lower Austria and Southern Bohemia, Association for climate protection, Edq.eu, Czech-Austrian household exhibition in Jihlava, CELBIOTECH, Kindergartens' co-operation...)



Lisbon and Gothenburg - conditions in CBC area

A lot to build upon:

- **Innovative policies in place** (Lower Austria - Regiostars Awards 2008 - special price for innovative policy, 6 clusters, Upper Austria - innovative policy since 1986, cluster initiatives since 1998, South Moravian Innovation Center...)
- **Universities, research institutes co-operation** (Vienna-Brno, České Budějovice-Linz, Krems-Nové Hradky and others)
- **Equal opportunities, energy sector innovative policies** (Austria) - inspiration?



Results from the first call

- promising
- Relatively good coverage of areas of support and stakeholders involved (**further efforts** needed to advertise the potential of the programme for **environmental measures**)
- **Aim:** to support **good quality projects only** for the best success of the programme
